**ALL SAINTS CHURCH
BOILER REPLACEMENT APPEAL**

The Church heating boiler has failed three times over the last two years:-



Boiler showing two failure points where the casing melted from escape of hot combustion gases from Heat Exchanger.

The cost of repair was around £1,000 each time to repair and spares are not now guaranteed. A replacement will cost around £12,000 and we would like to replace the boiler before the winter to ensure continuity of heating.

We are seeking contributions to help with the cost of this replacement.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

BACKGROUND

The Church Heating system was replaced around nine years ago and has experienced problems since. The original installation was modified by Austin Heating which resolved the operating problems (the original contractor refused to acknowledge an issue).

In 2013 the Boiler suffered a catastrophic Heat Exchanger failure and the response from Ideal Standard – who had taken over Keston – was abysmal. Austin Heating managed to source a replacement, fit this and get the heating operational again. We were very fortunate as the failure melted the boiler casing, however the thermal shut off activated to prevent more damage.

In 2014 another Heat Exchanger failed – again Austin managed to obtain and repair the boiler. Ideal Standard do not accept any manufacturing faults (although many of these Keston boilers are reported as failing) – however we did manage to obtain a “good-will” contribution from them (of around £900 for the two failures). Later in the year the boiler control panel failed – which Austin also managed to replace without loss of heating.

We are at a stage where we have no confidence in the boiler to continue operating, Ideal Standard ceased production of these boilers (when they took over Keston) and there is no guarantee of the availability of spare parts in the event of another failure. The PCC have consequently agreed that the boiler should be replaced to ensure continuity of heating in the Church

The replacement cost is approx. £12,000.

This replacement can initially be funded by using Church Reserves; however we do need these to be rebuilt through fund raising to cover the cost of the replacement boiler.
