DOZENS ARE LOOSE

DOZENS ARE BROKEN

Large areas of old disfiguring cement



Loose, cracked, missing



Ugly linoleum

# WHAT NEEDS TO BE DONE?

- \* PHOTOGRAPH THE FLOOR
- \* TAKE UP ALL THE TILES
- \* EXCAVATE TOP HALF OF SUBSTRATA
- \* REFILL
- \* ADD A WATERPROOF MEMBRANE
- \* LAY A LIME MORTAR SCREED
- \* RELAY TILES TO THE EXACT PATTERN OF THE ORIGINAL

# WHAT OPTIONS WERE CONSIDERED?

- \* PATCH UP THE AFFECTED AREAS
- \* COVER THE FLOOR WITH CARPET
- \* COVER THE FLOOR WITH LINOLEUM
- \* DO NOTHING

NONE ARE POSSIBLE

WHAT WILL IT COST ?

THE PROFESSIONAL ESTIMATE FOR THE FLOOR is  
£260,000

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE ?

THE ESTIMATE is 6 MONTHS

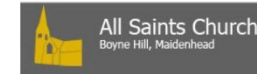

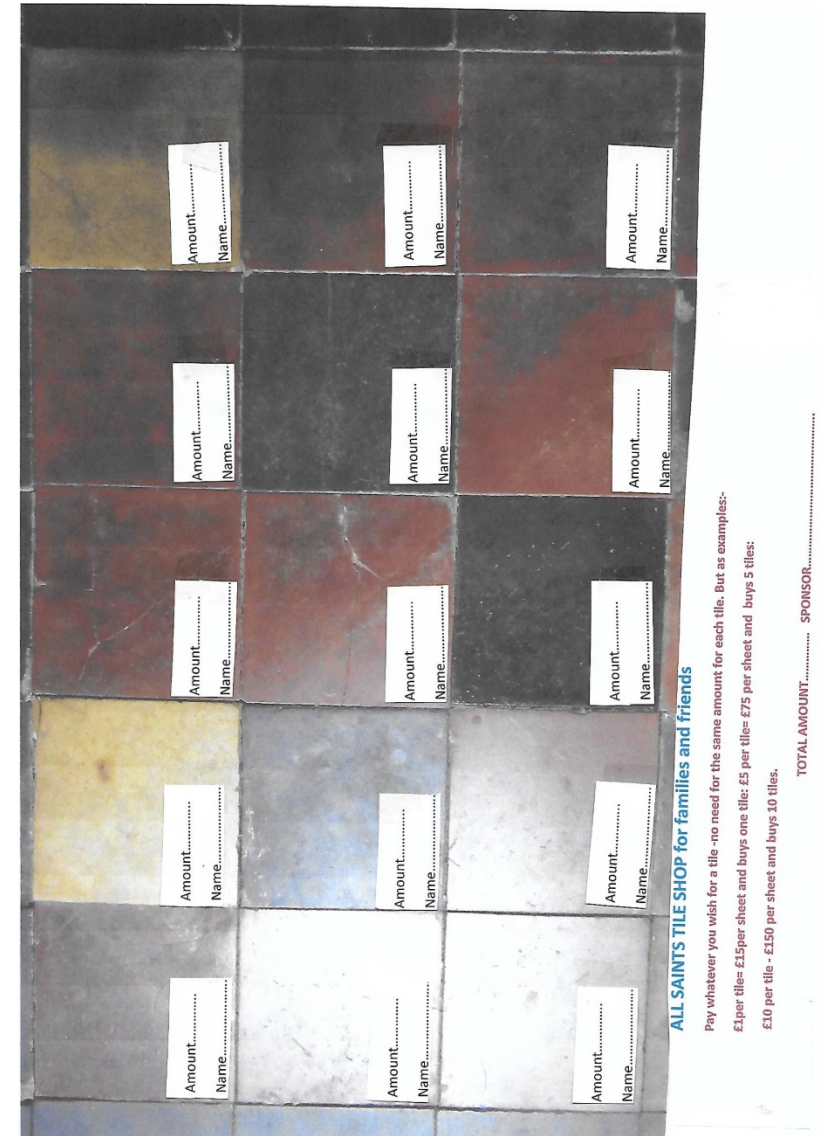

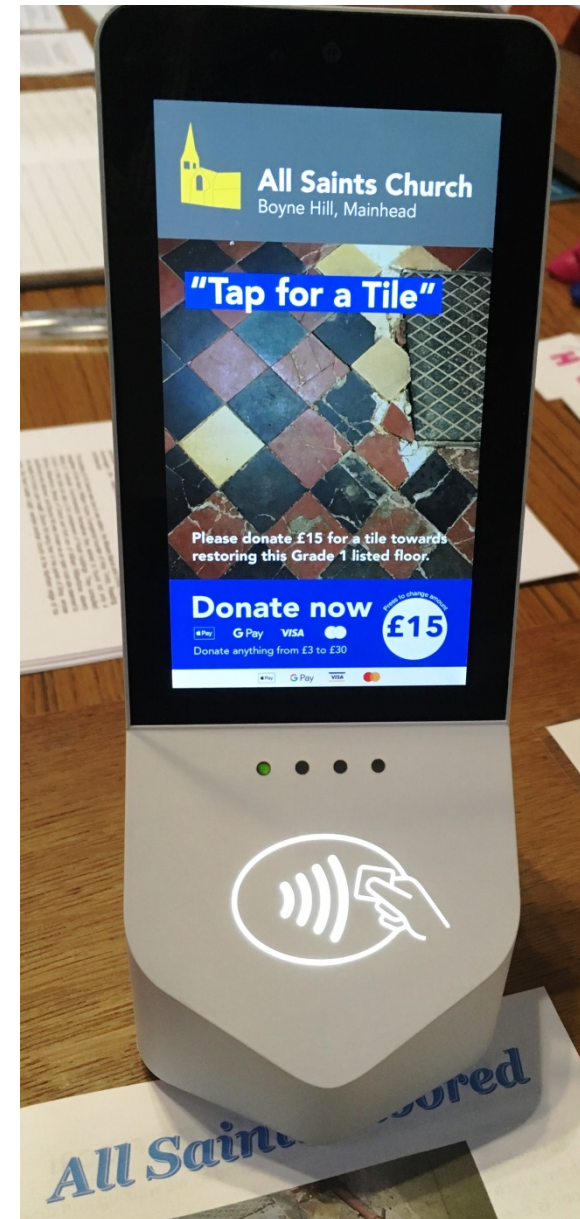
